The Identicom 977

New! 3G Service, Two-Way Voice Communication in Man-Down Alerts and SoloProtect Chaperone

The Identicom 977 introduces upgraded 3G technology, auto two-way voice communication for Man-Down alerts and a new Chaperone feature for greater functionality. The 977 retains its primary function of being a lone worker device used in risky situations, but, with SoloProtect Chaperone, users have an additional layer of comfort for non-alarm scenarios.

SoloProtect Chaperone reassures users they are not alone by providing accompaniment in non-alarm type situations. Activate Chaperone by pushing the multifunction button labeled '2' that sits behind the ID badge. Chaperone opens a two-way voice call to the Emergency Dispatch Center and is intended for use in situations where a user may feel slightly uncomfortable (walking to a vehicle at night, for instance) and would feel more at ease if a SoloProtect operator were on the line with them. Chaperone is for non-alarm situations and is not to be used where apparent risk is evident or suspected from past experiences and where the raising of a more discreet red alert is more appropriate.

In addition to the new Chaperone feature, the Identicom 977 is equipped with 3G technology and automatic initiation of a two-way voice call when a Man-Down alert is activated.

Core Functionality:

Identicom was designed for use across a wide range of lone worker applications to help staff reduce the risks they face. The Identicom 977 retains its key functionality as a dedicated lone worker device while improving on the legacy T777 with updated technology and additional features.

It is designed for use as part of a lone worker's dynamic risk assessment and is a direct link to 24/7 emergency monitoring when needed. Identicom facilitates discreet audio evidence capture, automatic Man-Down alerts and GPS location data. Deliberately designed to look and feel like a standard identification card holder, Identicom is wearable and therefore close at hand, discreet to use and not an overt communications device. It offers protection by reducing risk and helps an employer reduce costs and help meet their duty of care to a mobile workforce.

Who's using the Identicom 977?

The Identicom 977 fits many lone worker applications, all of which will benefit from the new features.

How Identicom Works:

Identicom looks and feels like a standard ID badge. Worn via lanyard or clip, it is discreet and always close at hand. The device connects via the mobile network with the Kings III Emergency Dispatch Center. Yellow alerts are used for check-in and location updates. Left via voice message, yellow alerts provide important contextual information if a subsequent red alert is raised. Red alerts open a one-way voice channel so workers feeling at risk are discreetly monitored by a live operator, trained in emergency communications and certified medical response dispatch should a situation require it.

The Kings III communications platform gathers GPS information and identifies the appropriate PSAP (Public Safety Answering Point). With SoloProtect, workers and employers alike are assured if a situation escalates, help is on the way.

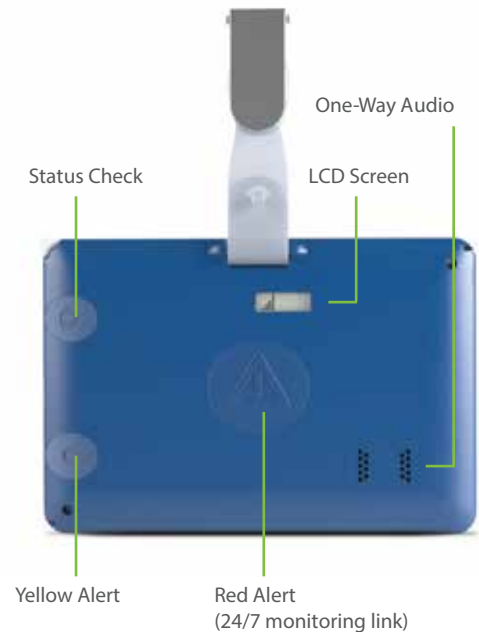
